INTRODUCTION

As we reflect on 2025, another tumultuous and sad year for the health of New Zealanders and direction of our country, we do so with immense gratitude for every supporter whose commitment to New Zealand Doctors Speaking Out with Science has sustained our work and mission. Easter weekend of 2025 marked our fourth anniversary: four years of standing firm in our pursuit of public safety, medical freedom, justice, and the fundamental right of doctors to practise conscientious medicine, speak freely and uphold our values.

What began in April 2021 as a small group of concerned medical professionals has grown into a movement that continues to make waves across New Zealand, and beyond. Together, we've challenged medical tyranny and political capture, supported those concerned and harmed by pandemic policies, and built a community that refuses to be silenced.

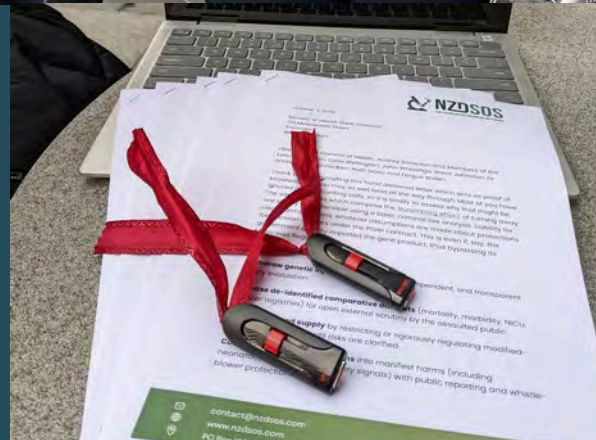
This report celebrates what we've accomplished together in 2025 and looks ahead to the vital work that remains.



ACHIEVEMENTS

2025 has been a year of pivotal advocacy. We presented evidence to the Royal Commission of Inquiry three times: in writing, in person, and at public hearings, producing a landmark 382-page document with over 300 references. We mobilised over 700 tracked submissions and thousands more personal stories from New Zealanders whose lives were changed by pandemic policies.

Our message reached further than ever. We launched our first-ever nationwide billboard campaign: donor-funded messages standing where social media algorithms can't censor us. With over 10 million impressions on Facebook alone, our reach is growing.



New Zealanders supported us by raising \$110,000 in just two weeks to cover the court costs from defending the Bill of Rights in our fluoride challenge and trying to bring the Medical Council to account for sidelining and silencing doctors. We continue to assert that the actions of the MCNZ have cost real human lives.

We presented 1,800 letters to the Ministry of Health and Medical Council from citizens concerned about public safety, basically to silence, as well as multiple detailed approaches to key government decision makers on the ongoing health fall-out from its vaccine campaign.

We supported doctor members with disciplinary hearings and provided ongoing support to members of the public with ACC vaccine injury claims.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Royal Commission report will be published in February 2026. Whatever it concludes, NZDSOS will be ready to respond appropriately. We remain committed to ensuring the wrong-doing around New Zealand's pandemic response is publicly revealed and that the many harmed and bereaved receive the recognition and support they deserve.

As the evidence of death and disability keeps mounting, we continue to put it firmly into the public arena, on the record and immoral to ignore, so that officials can never say they did not know, as the body of evidence builds.

With your continued support, we will keep pushing to restore a healthcare system built on honesty, informed consent, and respect for individual choice. Together, we are making a difference.





CORE VALUES

At NZDSOS, our work is guided by three foundational principles which shape everything we do:



MEDICAL FREEDOM

Defending the right to informed and un-coerced healthcare decisions, and the freedom for doctors to practise according to their professional knowledge and integrity, ethical obligations, and their role as citizens to speak freely.



ACCOUNTABILITY

Advocating for transparency and accuracy in information while holding systems and individuals accountable for public health decisions that cause harm.



SOVEREIGNTY

Empowering medical professionals, and New Zealanders generally, to reclaim control over healthcare and life decisions, free from undue influence or unaccountable external forces.

These pillars guide and inspire us as we face the many challenges ahead.

2025 ACHIEVEMENTS

This has been an important year for NZDSOS. We have accomplished much in the face of ongoing censorship and social, political and legal engineering, which has only been possible because of your support.

JAN - FEB

Gene Technology Bill Campaign

The year began and ended with an urgent fight. The Gene Technology Bill intends to deregulate genetic engineering across New Zealand's food and medicine systems, with irreversible consequences. NZDSOS mobilised our community to make submissions before the 17 February deadline, providing resources and templates to help New Zealanders understand what was at stake: deregulated gene products, corporate control of our food systems, unlabelled GE ingredients, and the end of GE-free New Zealand as we've known it. The bill has not passed yet and we continue to pressure those with the clout to defeat it.

FEB

Mass Medication: Fighting Water Fluoridation

We supported Fluoride Free NZ, including their series of presentations by US lawyer Michael Connett.

MAR

Covid-19 Inquiry Evidence Hub Launch

With the Royal Commission Phase 2 submission deadline approaching (27 April), we launched a dedicated Covid-19 Inquiry Evidence Hub to help New Zealanders participate. The hub provided resources, webinar replays, and step-by-step guidance to help people articulate their experiences effectively. Despite pessimism out there, including about senior Commission resignations and questions about transparency, we joined with other groups to mobilise our community. The **31,000+** stories subsequently received by the Commission demonstrate that collective voices create a powerful record that will one day be heard.

Celebrating Four Years of NZDSOS

In April 2025, NZDSOS proudly celebrated its 4th birthday, marking four years of necessary dedication to doctor and patient advocacy. From first gathering to write an urgent letter of concern to becoming a recognised voice for medical freedom with initial membership multiplying over 10-fold, this milestone reminded us how far we've come.

MAY

Royal Commission Written Submission

NZDSOS submitted a landmark 382-page evidence document to the Royal Commission of Inquiry, comprising over 300 references documenting the scale of harm from pandemic policies. This detailed submission laid the foundation for our in-person testimony.

First Nationwide Billboard Campaign

For the first time, NZDSOS took our message to the streets with billboards across New Zealand, in Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch. Funded by supporters through our "Back Our Billboard" campaign, these provocative signs stood where social media algorithms couldn't reach and where censorship held no power. Drivers saw them daily. Pedestrians photographed and shared them. They started conversations in communities nationwide. This is how we overcame digital censorship, and your donations made it possible. The campaign resonated so strongly that Vaccine Choice Canada and Australian senators adopted our messaging, extending the impact of your support across borders.

JUN 30

In-Person Royal Commission Presentation

Our team presented evidence directly to the Royal Commission, bringing the documented realities of vaccine injury and mandate consequences before the official inquiry. This 3-hour face-to-face was the culmination of months of preparation and research. The written documentation behind the presentations we gave is on our website.

JUL 10

Royal Commission Public Hearings

NZDSOS participated in public hearings, ensuring that the voices of those harmed by pandemic policies were formally recorded. Our testimony drew on evidence detailing profound harm.

AUG

Legal Defence Fund Launch

We launched the Legal Defence Fund to support our accrued court costs, the fallout from defending the Bill of Rights and doctors' duty to their patients, and the response was gratifying. Thank you. New Zealanders rallied to raise \$110,000 in just two weeks, demonstrating the depth of support for medical freedom and the growing public disgust with government and regulatory systems that have caused immense harm. These are issues NZDSOS continue to raise publicly.



OCT 3-5

Professional Members Gathering

NZDSOS professional members gathered from across the country to connect in person, plan for the year ahead, and strengthen our collective resolve. As we are spread across New Zealand, these opportunities to meet face-to-face are invaluable.

Letter Deliveries to MoH and MCNZ

NZDSOS members, supported by members of the public, hand-delivered formal letters to the Ministry of Health and Medical Council of New Zealand, presenting concern from the public regarding vaccine harm and the actions of the two organisations, and demanding accountability. This direct in-person advocacy is more important than ever as officials increasingly avoid engagement and remain unresponsive to email and formal correspondence. We received generic acknowledgements but no substantive response.

NOV

4

Gene Technology Rally

NZDSOS joined many New Zealanders rallying at Parliament to oppose the deregulation of genetic engineering. As the bill moved toward its second reading, we stood united with allies calling for proper scrutiny before this Pandora's box is opened.

15

Red Remembrance Day

For the fourth consecutive year, communities across New Zealand came together at noon to commemorate those harmed by mandates and vaccines. These gatherings honoured the human cost of pandemic policies while strengthening our collective commitment to accountability. Together we stand strong and united in truth.

DEC

Substantial Minority Report

To fill the actual and symbolic void left by covid Ministers when they refused to appear, we recorded evidence that the RCI and public ought to have heard. Notable Kiwi researchers collaborated to inform the Commissioners further as they examine key government decisions.

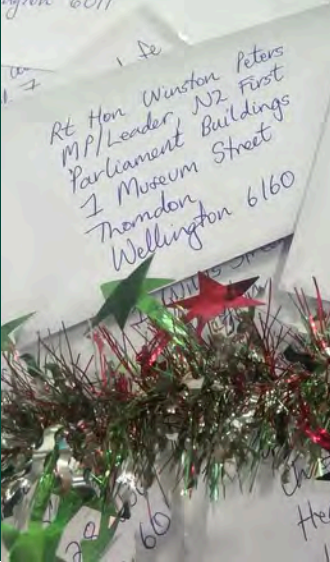

2025 OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE

Asking the questions others won't. Creating an official record that must not be ignored.

Throughout 2025, NZDSOS continued our tradition of direct advocacy, writing formally to officials, health authorities, and decision-makers. These letters present evidence, request accountability, and ensure that no one in power can claim they didn't know. Most are met with silence, but the record remains for when the time comes.

2025 OPEN LETTERS:

January 14 — *Medical Freedom on Trial: NZDSOS Court Case Verdict*

The High Court ruled on our legal challenge to the Medical Council's Guidance Statement. While the ruling did not go our way, we decided to lodge an appeal, defending doctors' rights to provide individualised treatments and to share medical opinions freely. We elected later not to proceed, based on advice from our legal team.

March 3 & 13 — *Letters to Health Minister Simeon Brown*

Following his appointment as Health Minister, we wrote twice to Minister Brown calling attention to New Zealand's health crisis: the "elephant in the room" that officials continue to ignore. A dismissive response was received.

June 25 — *Act Now or Answer Later*

An urgent open letter sent by registered post to 9 political and health officials presenting mounting evidence and demanding action before it's too late.

August 12 — *Refuting Prof Graham Le Gros*

Following his testimony to the Royal Commission, we issued a detailed rebuttal of statements made by Prof Graham Le Gros, correcting the record with peer-reviewed evidence.

August 19 — *Official Letter to the Royal Commission*

A formal submission to the Commissioners raising mRNA vaccine safety concerns and presenting evidence the inquiry needed to consider.

August 27 — *Request for Recall of Dr Helen Petousis-Harris's Testimony*

After Dr Petousis-Harris testified to the RCI, we requested that Commissioners recall and scrutinise her statements in light of contradicting evidence.

November 25 — *Profound Harm Confirmed*

An urgent open letter sent by registered post to 15 officials presenting confirmed evidence of harm at a time when New Zealand faces unprecedented levels of injury.

December 9 — *Letter to Colorectal Surgeons*

When two surgeons publicly raised alarms about an increase in aggressive bowel cancers in young New Zealanders, we wrote to them, asking the question no one in mainstream medicine seems willing to consider.

LOOKING AHEAD TO 2026

A pivotal year ahead. Building on our achievements, moving forward with the truth.

Will 2026 be a defining year for medical, and all, freedom in New Zealand? With all hands needed on deck, we hope so. The Royal Commission of Inquiry report will be presented to parliament in February, just weeks away. And with a general election on 7 November 2026, the political landscape offers further opportunities to pressure elected representatives to stop the silence, cover-ups and profound wrong-doing.

When that Royal Commission report is released, NZDSOS will be ready to respond. Whatever it concludes, we will ensure the full truth about New Zealand's pandemic response continues to be told as it is uncovered, and that those harmed are not forgotten.

As we progress into 2026, NZDSOS remains committed to seeing the truth told.



Responding to the Royal Commission

The inquiry has received 31,000+ personal stories, mostly of harm and damage. We will work to hold officials responsible for this record and push for genuine accountability, not just "lessons learned."



Influencing the Election Conversation

With a general election on the horizon, we have an opportunity to make politicians aware and accountable for the continued toll from the largest medical assault in history. We must not tolerate the lies supporting the other agendas being foisted on us either. Whether on more mRNA products, gender, fluoride, the encroaching digital prison, climate, Agenda 2030, and collectivism disguised as making us safer, your voice matters more than ever.



Challenging the MCNZ

We will continue our legal efforts to defend doctors' rights to their conscience-driven professional opinions, to issue warnings and share medical opinions freely. The Medical Council's gross conflicts of interest and absurd assessment of covid vaccines as "zero-risk" products must be addressed.



Fronting up to the Witch-hunt

Another 3 of our founding members face their disciplinary tribunals this year. We continue to support each other, demand the persecution stops and call for justice.



Public Awareness Campaigns

Expanding community understanding of critical issues including vaccine harms, gene technology, and ongoing threats to health sovereignty. Our billboards, bumper stickers, and physical presence will continue to bypass the relentless censorship of our social media and reach New Zealanders directly.



Supporting the Injured

Through the Vaccine Injury Sponsorship Fund and NZDHHC Clinic, we continue providing practical support to New Zealanders navigating any health challenges, not just covid-related.

CLOSING

Our goal has always been to put ourselves out of work: to accomplish what we set out to do and close our doors, mission accomplished. Until that day, we'll keep fighting for a healthcare system where honesty, informed consent, and patient welfare are foremost. But we are realistic what needs to happen first: acknowledgement and recognition of the sheer scale of damage still unfolding from the covid response and in particular the jabs. Cancer, sudden death, autoimmune disease, amyloid-like undissolvable clots and gross contamination with foreign DNA are the new realities that must be confronted. NZDSOS members will continue in various projects to bring awareness and then change.
